SAT scores may be used to waive all or some sections of the ACCUPLACER. Download your detailed SAT score report from [collegeboard.org](http://collegeboard.org) and email it to [studentservices@montcalm.edu](mailto:studentservices@montcalm.edu). Once you have completed or submitted an assessment, you are ready to meet with a counselor to make an academic plan and register for classes.

### SAT scores needed to waive ACCUPLACER assessment

(Individual test sub scores)

Writing and Language	25
Reading	25
Math	26

ACCUPLACER can be waived if you transfer in equivalent college classes or a college degree.
